

Social Security Benefits

Program 500+ For every second and next child under eighteen years of age a family receives 500 PLN per month (approx. 110 EUR). Old-age pension is possible even after only 15 years of work, and the benefits are related to the salary. Social pension is available in Poland to a person of full age and fully incapable of work due to a physicaldisability.





Image: Weight with the second stress of the seco
